We hope to spend a good amount of that money and decide at a later date. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There is currently no plans for a home tour in 2018. Work disproportionately falls on a small amount of people, with almost no board participation. Also, the PTA of DCIS did not provide any volunteers. - We need more homes. Hard to get home. Thanks to Terri we got enough homes. - Need more volunteers. - Can the board be more involved with the planning and execution of the event. - Can we use the money for public art? Bike lock art or planters. \$6000-\$9000 worth of art, both on Broadway and on Santa Fe. • T-Shirt: We have spent \$1,300 on banner and t-shirts and we have received \$300 in sales. Is this money that was blown, can we bring them to events? Holiday party, ice cream social? • Garden: Richard and his wife helped and also hired someone to cut down the plants. Denver Health was very helpful in removing some of the debris. Sprinklers are broken, but the timer works. \$240 of \$500 was spent, but are not going to spend too much more until we figure out what we have and what we want to keep.
