### **Denver Parks and Rec representative Fred Weiss to discuss liquor in the park**

- Probate and policy
- Should policy change?
- Changes
  - Category 1: General alcohol consumption
    - Now only 3.2% allowed but 3.2 is going away
    - State may pass law letting localities decide
  - Category 2: Permitted events
    - Confusing – different rules for different parks
    - Alcohol served in any park where a permit is issued if they get license
    - Server issue – state law changing
  - Slippery slope issue into concessions in the park?
  - Special event license for non-profits only
- Admission based event
  - No ticketed events/invited parks
  - Rest period in parks
- Dailey Park
  - Now can have 400 people
  - New can have 400 people with alcohol
  - Process
    - Establish rest period
    - Apply to parks and rec

- Non-profit
- Public hearing may be required
- Liquor license
- Must have barrier around where alcohol is served if it is sold but not if it's free
- Notifications automatic to council members but not RNOs
